The Skagit Valley Family YMCA Emergency Closure Policy is for snow, severe weather, power outages, disaster, or any unforeseen emergency. All before & after school program participants are encouraged to have a backup plan for emergencies. The YMCA will make every attempt to provide care, however, the YMCA cannot guarantee that staff will always be able to get to the schools or that the school will be open in every emergency situation.

If **school is canceled**, the YMCA does not have access to the schools and therefore we cannot provide care. In the event of a prolonged closure, we will do our best to provide a camp day for our families, at selected schools.

- **If school is delayed:**

The YMCA will make every attempt to arrive on site at the regularly scheduled time for the before school program. Please understand that traveling on these mornings may take longer than expected.

- **If school is cancelled:**

The YMCA will close the program and contact parents for pick up. If you work out of the area, emergency pick up will be contacted.

- **If school is let out early:**

We will open when school is released. If we must close early, we will call parents and request children be picked up as soon as possible.
